Parent / Player Information Sheet

Dear Parent and Player,

Thank you for attending our training and selection sessions for the NV Patriots 2000, we appreciate your time and interest in being part of our team. Please take a moment to read through this sheet as it will answer a lot of your questions.

Objectives:

1. To complete a team that can be competitive in nature and that has in its ranks players that are truly dedicated to the sport of soccer.

Practices:

- Spring practices start Saturday February 12, 2011 weather permitting. (See the online calendar for specific dates www.nvpatriots.com)
- There are 3 practices per week. 2 in the evenings during the week of 1.5 hrs. each and one on Saturday afternoons 2 hrs. long.
- Practices will decrease once games start so that soccer days continue to be 3 times per week.

Where we'll play:

- The team will participate in the GBYSL (Great Basin Youth Soccer League) out of Reno.
- League games start around April 1st and end around the mid June.
- Games are typically once in the middle of the week around 5:30 or 6 PM and on Saturdays starting some times at 8 or 9 am and can be played up to around 3 pm. There are about 8 to 10 league games.
- Locations for games are in Sparks, South Reno, Carson City, Gardnerville and some times Truckee and South Tahoe. Depending on schedule.
- The team will play about 15 to 18 games between league, scrimmages and tournament games in the spring.

Tournaments:

- The team will participate in One Local tournament. Either in Reno in June or Carson City in April. Tournaments include 3 games minimum, 2 Saturday and 1 on Sunday morning. A game on Sunday afternoon may also be possible depending how the team does on the previous 3 games of the tournament.

Cost Per Player for the Spring Season: \$200 to \$225 (Approx)

- League Registration: \$100 Per Player Approx.
- Club/Team Fees \$50 Per Player.
- 1 Tournament \$50 Per Player Approx
- Uniforms: We will not be buying new uniforms for the spring! We will use the current shorts/socks that the players were given from the rec league and the white jerseys. For new players, we will have to purchase white jerseys to match and they are approximately \$15. We will need everyone's jerseys to add the team/club logo this winter.
- New Uniforms and warm ups will be bought for the Fall 2011 season.
- **We will not charge coaching fees for the U10 team, but please do not take this for granted!** Our coaching experience, credentials, and success with all of our teams is what other clubs around aim for without success, while still charging unreasonable "coaching" fees. We coach because we love the sport and we know that we can develop better players without putting another financial stress on families. *Other clubs charge \$500 to \$1000 per player and some even charge a monthly and per game fee.*

How we pay for it all:

Parents are required to pay for the cost of each player, however, we try to off-set the costs by actively seeking sponsors which go towards the uniform cost and sponsorship of players with need of financial aid. For this, parents are asked to help secure sponsors for the team. We will post our sponsors on our web site.

When will you know if your child made the team?

We will call everyone within a few hours from our last session on November 6.

What are we looking for?

Players that want to take their game to the next level, are willing to listen and be better players, and that show potential. Parents are required to **NOT** coach their child, especially from the sidelines.
